Jesus Chooses the Moment over the Madness.

Jesus Brings Both the Miraculous Power of God and the Tireless Compassion of God to the Pleading People of God.	
Jesus Chooses the Person over the Product.

Jesus is Not in the World Today to Simply Dispatch Blessings. He Treasures You as a Person. Don't Draw Near to Him for Anything Less.

Jesus Chooses Faith over Fear.
