The Power of the Cross I Corinthians 1:17-19; 2:2,5

I decided that while I was with you I would forget about everything except Jesus Christ and his death on the cross... 5 This was so that your faith would be in God's power and not in human wisdom (1Cor. 2:2,5)

¹⁷ For Christ did not send me to baptize, but to preach the gospel—and not with clever speech, so that the cross of Christ would not become useless. 18 For the message about the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. 19 For it is written, "I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and I will thwart the cleverness of the intelligent".

II. The Cross brings the Power of God into your life.

...but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. (1 Cor. 1:18b)
