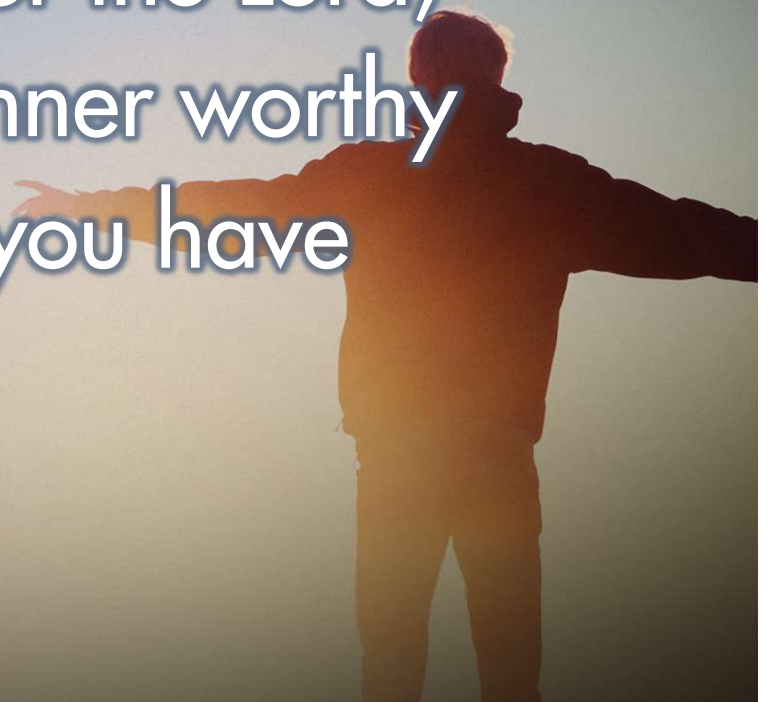

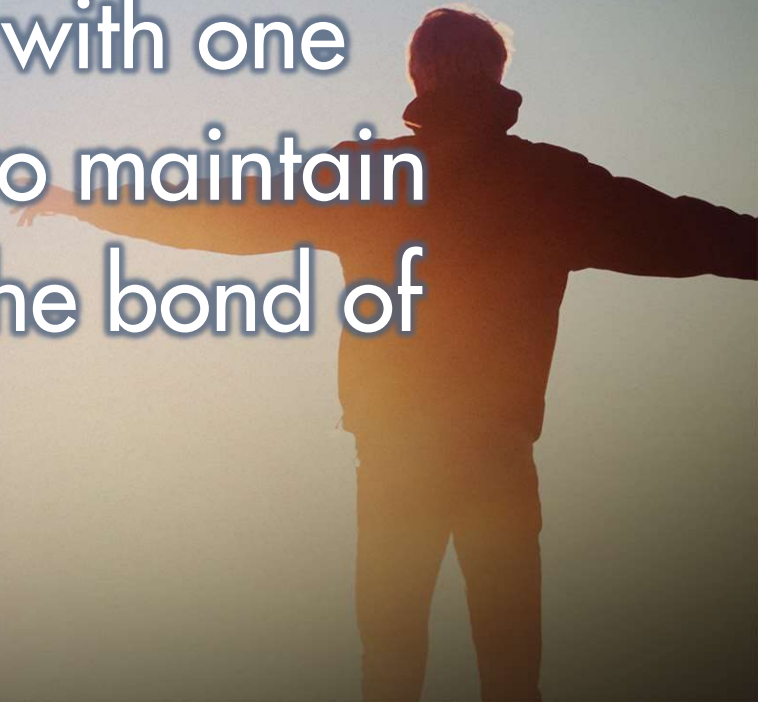
**EPHESIANS 4:1-6**

been called,

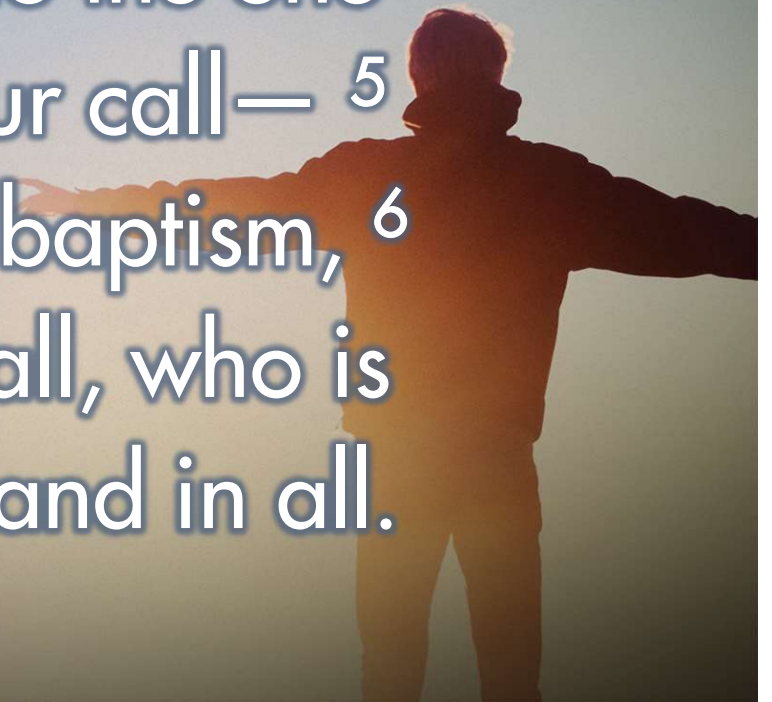


<sup>2</sup> with all humility and gentleness,

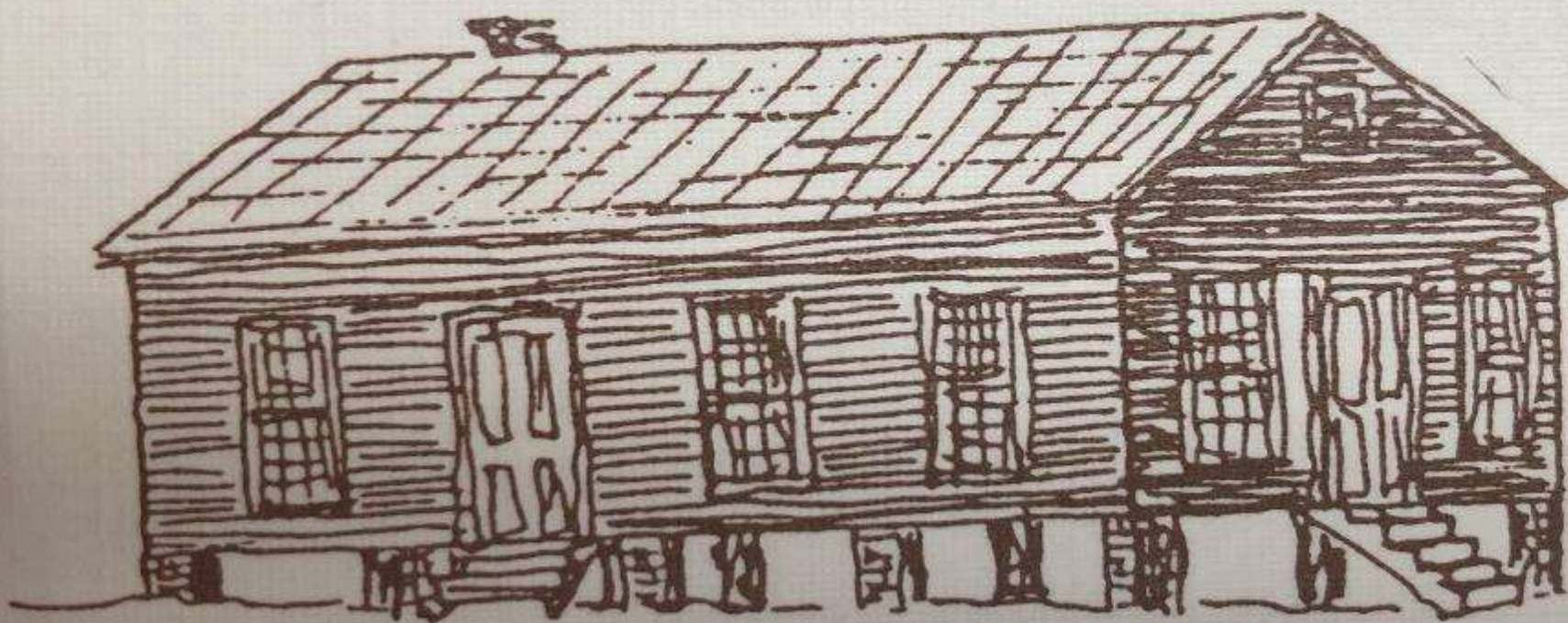
