EPHESIANS 6:15



¹⁰ Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might. ¹¹ Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil.



12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places.



13 Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm.



14 Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness,

¹⁶ In all circumstances take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming darts of the evil one;



¹⁷ and take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God



What is the Gospel of Peace?

⁶ For while we were still **WEAK**, at the right time Christ died for the <u>UNGODLY</u>. ⁷ For one will scarcely die for a RIGHTEOUS person—though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die— 8 but God shows his love for us in that while we were still SINNERS, Christ died for us. 9 Since, therefore, we have now been JUSTIFIED by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from the WRATH of God. ¹⁰ For if while we were ENEMIES we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life. 11 More than that, we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received reconciliation.
